– MOVING CHECKLIST –

**BEFORE YOU LEAVE:**

**Address Change**

- Post Office
- Charge accounts and credit cards
- Subscriptions
- Friends and relatives
- Insurance company

**Bank**

- Transfer necessary bank funds.
- Obtain a cashier's check for closing real estate transactions.
- Arrange for credit references.

**Utility Companies**

- Stop service on gas, electric, water & telephone.
- Get refunds on any utility deposits.

**Delivery Service**

- Stop or change delivery services.

**Medical, Dental, Prescription Histories**

- Ask your doctor and dentist for referrals.
- Transfer needed prescriptions, eyeglasses & x-rays.

**Pets**

- Ask your veterinarian about regulations for pet licenses, vaccination, tags, etc.

**Do Not Forget To:**

- Empty your freezer and plan use of perishable foods.
- Defrost your freezer and clean refrigerator.
- Have appliances serviced for moving.
- Make arrangements for TV, antenna & satellite connections.
- Check with your moving company about insurance coverage, packing/unpacking, labor, arrival day, various shipping supplies, method and time of expected payment & special needs of infants or pets.

- Carry traveler's checks or cash for quick available funds.
- Carry jewelry and important documents or use registered mail.
- Let a close friend or relative know your traveling route and schedule.
- Double-check your closets, drawers & shelves to be sure they are empty.
- Leave all old keys and garage door openers with Realtor®.

**AT YOUR NEW ADDRESS:**

- Look into service for telephone, gas, electricity, water & cable.
- Check pilot light on stove, hot water heater, incinerator & furnace.
- Have all appliances checked.
- Ask your mailman for any mail he may be holding for your arrival.
- Have your new address recorded on driver's license.
- Visit the city offices and register for voting.
- Register your car within five days after arrival in a new state or a penalty may have to be paid when getting new license plates.
- Obtain a city inspection sticker and transfer your motor club membership.
- Apply for state driver's license.
- Register your family in your new place of worship.
- Register your children in school.
- Arrange for medical services. IE. Doctor, dentist, veterinarian, etc.
